EXCLUSIVELY for Women and Girls! - No Male Riders

When: Saturday, April 9, 2022 (Rain or shine, there is no make-up day, no refunds)

Where: Las Positas College, Livermore, CA

From I-680 traveling North or South take I-580 East toward Livermore. Exit at Isabel Ave, and go North. Cross Portola Ave. onto Campus Hill Drive, continue to Las Positas College Parking lot. Park as directed by traffic monitors.

Time: Registration between 6:00 and 9:00 a.m. Cinderella is NOT a Race. Course closes at 5:00 p.m.

Cost includes parking, Cinderella patch, lunch, rest stops, SAG support, plus post ride refreshments and Cinderella Expo. A Cinderella Classic ride patch is awarded to every rider. A route map and wrist band will be provided. No refunds.

 Cinderella Classic - \$80 (Cash, credit card, Apple Pay, Android Pay or check payable to Valley Spokesmen)

This unique bicycle tour for women of all ages and abilities starts in Livermore and winds through Diablo, San Ramon, and Amador Valleys. This metric century (100k/65 miles) is mostly flat with a few moderate hills. From the start at the Las Positas College in Livermore, the ride circles north along the base of beautiful Mt. Diablo to Danville, where it turns south through San Ramon and Pleasanton, then east through the vineyards of Livermore, before returning.

 Cinderella Challenge - \$80 (Cash, credit card, Apple Pay, Android Pay or check payable to ValleySpokesmen)

The Challenge route is for fit experienced riders only. The course has an additional 2,000 feet of elevation gain with significant ascents/descents. Entry to the Challenge route is monitored and closes at 10:00 am.

 Cinderella Short - \$50 (Cash, credit card, Apple Pay, Android Pay or check payable to ValleySpokesmen)

The Cinderella Short route is a 30 mile mostly flat ride through the East and North Livermore. From the start at Las Positas in Livermore, the ride circles to the South and East on city streets to Greenville Rd where it connects up with the Classic Route.

Be Prepared: A bicycle helmet is required! Please check your bike, or have it checked, before you arrive to make certain the condition of all components (brakes, tire, wheels, derailleur) are ready for this ride. The Valley Spokesmen will not inspect your bicycle. Two local bike shops will be on hand to assist with minor mechanical problems.

Support: There will be SAG support patrolling the route if you need assistance. Rest stops will have fruit, drinks and snacks, plus a cold lunch will be served at mid-point. Food is served at the end of the ride.

Family/Friends: Your spouse, family and friends are welcome to meet you at the finish and all are invited to the Cinderella Expo where bicycle manufacturers, clothing suppliers and women's organizations will have booths.
