Challenge Yourself on Mt. Diablo -In Memory of Joe Shami



n Sunday, October 3, VSBC will be hosting the 38 annual Mount Diablo Challenge - In Memory of Joe Shami! This will be the one in-person riding event put on by your club this year. Try to beat your last time or

volunteer to support the event. Either way, it will be a day to enjoy and remember.

Thirty-nine years ago, the VS Club hosted the first Mt. Diablo Challenge in memory of Joan Walt who passed away of myocarditis, which was a rare heart ailment. Any profit made was donated to the American Heart Association.

A few years later, the Children's Hospital Auxiliary (in Oakland) took it over and the profit was contributed to the Heart Department and later other departments at the hospital.

Next, the American Lung Association took on the job of sponsorship and, more recently Save Mount Diablo (SMD). In 2016, SMD asked VSBC if they would like to host the event while SMD focused on other fund-raisers more in line with their expertise. Thus in 2017 the hosting of the Mount Diablo Challenge had returned to the club that started it.

Meanwhile, over the past 12 years, Joe Shami (in his mid-seventies) began riding his Trek bicycle to the summit of Mount Diablo at least once per week for an amazing 615 weeks! Tragically, Joe was killed April 13 while cycling in a traffic circle in Lafayette. His love for Mt. Diablo and his tireless work to make it a safer place for cyclists will be celebrated this year with the *Mt. Diablo Challenge -In Memory of foe Shami!*
